



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN

THE BOARD OF REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM OF GEORGIA BY AND ON BEHALF OF THE UNIVERSITY OF GEORGIA AND THE NATIONAL

UNIVERSITY TORIBIO RODRÍGUEZ DE MENDOZA DE AMAZONAS

The Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia by and on behalf of The University of Georgia, represented by its Associate Provost for Global Engagement, Dr. Martin Kagel, based in Athens, Georgia, U.S.A.; and the National University Toribio Rodríguez de Mendoza de Amazonas, represented by the Rector, Jorge Luis Maicelo Quintana, based in Street Higos Urco N° 342, Chachapoyas, Amazonas, Perú.

(hereinafter named THE PARTIES)

WHEREAS both parties acknowledge the importance of establishing cultural and

scientific relations between higher education institutions belonging to

different countries, to achieve their institutional aims,

WHEREAS both parties share areas of common interest and similar academic goals

in teaching and research;

THEREFORE the parties have agreed to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding

(hereinafter referred to as MOU).

Article 1

The Parties agree to exchange information on their respective academic programs and research activities, to facilitate some or all of the following:

1. Creation and strengthening of masters and doctoral programs;

support the creation and management of masters and doctoral programs in engineering, health sciences, agrarian sciences, environmental sciences and economic sciences.

2. Student Mobility;

exchange of graduate and post-graduate students, with particular reference to PhD. Students; study-abroad programs and summer courses; language training; internships/traineeships.

3. Research Collaborations;

exchange of researchers, faculty members, graduate students and postdoctoral fellows; development of collaborative research; joint research programs; collaborative scholarly publications.

4. Joint Programs;

collaboration in the training of students or professors through the





creation and strengthening of doctoral academic programs; co-supervision of doctoral theses.

Knowledge Transfer and Co-creation;

exchange of publications and other academic materials; exchange of academic staff for teaching and research; conferences and seminars; exchange of administrative staff.

Other cooperation opportunities can be jointly agreed upon by the Parties in the future under a separate agreement.

Article 2

For the development of the above activities, The Parties agree to draw up a specific agreement for the implementation of the programs and activities of cooperation, in compliance with legislation and regulations in force in the country where they are implemented and provided that relevant funding is confirmed by either party.

Article 3

The Parties shall designate a representative responsible for overseeing the development of this MOU.

For the Universidad Nacional Toribio Rodríguez de Mendoza, the Director of the Institute for Research, Innovation and Development for the Agricultural and Agroindustrial Sector.

And for the University of Georgia, the Director of International Initiatives.

Article 4

This MOU will not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to the other. The Parties acknowledge in the absence of any specific written agreement to the contrary, each Party will bear its costs and expenses in establishing and conducting programs and activities listed under this MOU. The Parties may apply for funding from local, national and international institutions to implement the above-mentioned activities.

Article 5

This MOU shall take effect upon the signature of both parties and continue to be effective for five (5) years.

The provisions of this MOU in respect of any ongoing exchange program or any other form of cooperative activity under this MOU shall continue to apply until their completion unless both Parties mutually agree in writing to the earlier termination of the program or activity.

Article 6

This MOU is written in duplicate copies in English and Spanish, with each of the copies being equally authentic, and signed by their duly authorized





representatives.

In any case, the English version will prevail for the interpretation of each clause.

Each Party will be responsible for any finance charge related to the execution of this MOU, according to the rules and regulations applicable in each institution.
